1.0 Agriculture is the main stay for the 80% of rural population of the state as their employment and primary income generating activity. However, agricultural economy of the state Jharkhand state is characterized by dependence on nature, low investment, low productivity, mono-cropping with paddy as the dominant crop, inadequate irrigation facilities and small and marginal land holdings, etc. Further, dependence of agriculture on vagaries of monsoon with continuous erratic rainfall pattern has made the sector very vulnerable, affecting food security in the state apart from its overall contribution to the GDP resulting in heavy dependence (nearly 50%) on outside market to feed its populace.

1.1 It has been the constant endeavor of the state govt. to increase the production and productivity of various crops in the state by optimum utilization of various inputs, like - water, seeds, fertilizer, pesticide, etc.

1.2 Lack of adequate soil testing facilities in the state has resulted into an un-planned and un-scientific use of chemical fertilizers which results in increased cost of inputs along with affecting the potential agricultural production, which would have increased if sufficient soil testing facilities were made available in the state.

1.3 The state has limited Soil Testing Laboratories (STL) in Ranchi, Latehar, Chatra, Gumla, Hazaribagh, Giridih, Dumka, Sahebganj, Godda and Gumla, districts, which is highly in-adequate, keeping in mind the magnitude of soil testing exercise expected to be carried out.

1.4 Accordingly, it has been decided to promote Soil Testing Facilities in the state by encouraging Public-Private-Partnership (PPP) with Govt./Semi - Govt./Non-Govt. Companies/organizations/agencies to construct, equip and operate Soil Testing Laboratories in Dhanbad, Bokaro, Jamshedpur (East Singhbhum), Koderma, Ramgarh, Khunti, Lohardaga, Daltonganj (Palamau), Deoghar, Seraikella- Kharswan, Jamtara and Simdega districts of Jharkhand.

1.5 Thus, Expression of Interest (EoI) are invited from Govt./Semi - Govt./Non Govt. Companies/organizations/agencies to construct, equip and operate Soil Testing Laboratories in Dhanbad, Bokaro, Jamshedpur (East Singhbhum), Koderma, Ramgarh, Khunti, Lohardaga, Daltonganj (Palamau), Deoghar, Seraikella- Kharswan, Jamtara and Simdega districts of Jharkhand.

2.0 EOI Procedure

2.1 The Bidders should submit the proposals in two parts:

- a. Technical Bid
- b. Financial Bid
- i) Technical part should contain all such details as mentioned in the Bid Document.
- ii) Financial part should contain the financial bid inclusive of all admissible taxes, duties and levies, etc. The details of the financial bid should also be included for better appreciation of the bid.
- iii) These two parts should be submitted in separate sealed and super scribed envelops.
- iv) **Both the envelops should then be sealed in a third envelop marked as " Expression of Interest for setting up of Soil Testing Laboratory in(name of the district), Jharkhand "**

- (b) Invitation of Expression of Interests (EoI) from reputed companies/organizations/Govt./Semi - Govt/Non Govt. Companies/organizations/agencies to construct, equip and operate Soil Testing Laboratories in Dhanbad, Bokaro, Jamshedpur (East Singhbhum), Koderma, Ramgarh, Khunti, Lohardaga, Daltonganj (Palamau), Deoghar, Seraikella- Kharswan, Jamtara and Simdega districts of Jharkhand as per this tender document.
- (c) The firm should submit its offer duly sealed and super scribed on the top of the envelope- The name of the firm, EOI notice number, name of tender, date of opening and details of earnest money deposited.

- (d) EOI can be submitted by hand or by post. If the tender is sent by post, the department will not be responsible for any delay in postal transit.

The sealed EOI should be submitted in two parts i.e. Part-I, **Technical Bid** and Part-II, Financial Bid in separate envelopes duly super scribed on the top of the envelope Part-I Technical Bid Part-II, Financial Bid.

On the date of opening, only Part-I (Technical Bid) will be opened. Subsequently Part-II (Financial Bid) of only those EOIs will be opened, which qualify after technical evaluation.

- (e) EOI received after due date and time will be summarily rejected.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

- a) Construction of the building of Soil Testing Laboratory (STL) proposed to be set up as per the design and estimate (Annexure-I) of Agriculture & Cane Development Department of Jharkhand against the funds provided by the department for this purpose within the prescribed time frame.
- b) Procurement, Installation, Commissioning, Operations and maintenance of the Soil Testing equipments as per the minimum requirement indicated by the Agriculture & Cane Development Department, Jharkhand (Annexure-II) out of own funds of the selected agency. *The Make and quality of the equipments has to be vetted by BAU.*
- c) Providing soil testing facilities to minimum 10,000 farmers of the district annually within stipulated time and to take all appropriate actions technically required in this regard.
- d) Issue of Soil Health Cards (SHC) in proforma prescribed (Annexure-III) by the Agriculture & Cane Development Department, Jharkhand.
- e) *After one year the performance of the agency will be reviewed and the Department may ask the agency to conduct additional test for*

secondary nutrient / micro nutrient or any other test and may also ask to install additional equipment for the same. The rate offered for the equipments / additional test will not be more than the rate analyzed / approved by BAU/ Govt. of India.

- f) Operations, maintenance, time to time repairs and upkeep of the constructed building and the equipments installed and commissioned for such soil testing purposes.

3. DEPOSIT OF EARNEST MONEY

- (a) EOI must be accompanied with an earnest money EMD of Rs. 25,000 (**Twenty Five thousand only**) failing which the EOI will be rejected and price part will not be opened.
- (b) The Earnest Money should be deposited of account payee bank draft in favor of the Director Agriculture, Jharkhand, payable at Ranchi.
- (c) Cheque/ Bank Guarantee/ fixed deposit receipt money orders etc are not acceptable towards deposit of earnest money.
- (d) In no case E/M will be accepted after opening of EOI.
- (e) Details of E/M i.e. draft number/NSC and date should be indicated on the cover of the envelope otherwise the tender may not be opened and returned to the party.

4. REIMBURSEMENT OF THE COST OF SOIL TESTING FACILITY PROVIDED TO FARMERS:

- 4.1 Department of Agriculture & Cane Development, Jharkhand, Ranchi would reimburse the 90% cost of soil testing facilities on quarterly basis provided to the farmers of the state on per sample cost as decided by the department.
- 4.2 The cost of testing such soil sample should be clearly quoted in figures as well as in words in the prescribed format attached (Annexure-IV).

Rate/Price quoted should be inclusive of all taxes (CST/VAT/etc) freight insurance, cost of procuring samples, printing and issue of soil health card, operational cost incurred upon man power. Full breakup of such cost should be mentioned so as to enable the department to scrutinize and finalize the cost of Soil Testing Facility per sample.

5. CONSTRUCTION OF SOIL TESTING LABORATORY BUILDING :

- 5.1 Interested eligible agencies etc should quote the cost of construction of the soil testing laboratory as per the Design, estimate and Bill of Quantity (BOQ) (Annex-I).
- 5.2 Such applicants are expected to quote the construction cost, which should not be above or below 10% of the estimated amount mentioned in Bill of Quantity (BOQ) in the prescribed format attached, failing which, their application stands rejected.
- 5.3 The selected agency would have enter into the agreement with the officer as designated by Department of Agriculture & Cane Development, Jharkhand and ensure construction as per the quality and specifications mentioned in the estimate, within the specified period.
- 5.4 The designated officer of the department would ensure timely measurement of the work done and payment against the same as per the provisions of the PWD code.

6. PENALTY

The construction work shall be guaranteed under penalty clause. The terms of penalty is one percent (2%) of the value of work delayed for each month or part there of with a ceiling of 10%.

7. VALIDITY PERIOD

Tendered should specify the validity period of their offer which should be for a period of at least 360 days from the date of opening of tender.

8. TIME SCHEDULE

8.1 The selected agency is expected to submit a work plan for the project within 15 days of issue of work order.

8.2 The civil construction works has to be completed within a period of six months of issue of work order for construction of soil testing laboratory building.

8.3 After completion of the soil testing building, installation and commissioning of all equipment etc for soil testing facilities within eight months of issue of work order for construction of soil testing laboratory building.

9. INCOME TAX, SALES TAX CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE & OTHER DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED.

9.1 An attested photocopy of the pan card, ITR of last financial year, and Valid Sales Tax Clearance certificate, J.S.T./ C.S.T./VAT should be submitted along with the tender.

9.2 If the bidding agency is not registered under Jharkhand sales Tax department then they must give an undertaking through notary affidavit that "They will complete the work after payment of JVAT/Jharkhand Sales Tax on their own, if applicable."

10. TEST CERTIFICATE

Test certificates, where applicable should be furnished in triplicate.

11. BLACKLISTING/DEBARMENT

Affidavit through first class magistrate mentioning that the applicant company/agency is not black listed by any Government/Semi government organization".

A draft for affidavit to be submitted along with the tender document is annexed (Annexure- V).

12. AUTHORIZATION LETTER

The authorization letter (Annexure- VI) to submit such EoI should be addressed to Director, Agriculture, Jharkhand, Krishi Bhawan, Kanke Road, Ranchi. Photocopy or fax copy shall not be accepted.

13. TECHNICAL EVALUATION:

13.1 The technical bid submitted will be evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:- (Max-100 marks)

Note: Zero in any of the criteria mentioned above will automatically call for disqualification.

13.2 All supporting documents should be enclosed as proof, to enable objective and transparent marking for each of the above criteria.

14. SELECTION PROCESS

14.1 A nominated committee will evaluate the technical bid received. Technical assessment will be based on technical evaluation criteria as mentioned in para 18.

14.2 On the basis of technical assessment, *the agencies have to score in each of the criteria* and agencies having a score of more than 50% will be selected and the financial packet of only such agencies etc. will be opened.

14.3 The work order will be awarded to the company/organization, who quotes the minimum for construction of the Soil Testing Laboratory as per the estimate, specifications and quality as specified in the tender document.

14.4 The company/organization shall have to provide the soil testing facilities at the rate per sample testing as decided by the Department of Agriculture & Cane Development, Jharkhand, which would be uniform for the whole state.

This cost per sample soil testing would be decided in consultation with various stake holders such as State Agricultural University, KVK's, Research Institution, Farmers, etc.

15. OTHER INFORMATIONS

15.1 The land for such Soil Testing Laboratory (STL) shall be provided by the Department of Agriculture & Cane Development, Jharkhand.

However, the ownership right of the land and the building constructed upon it, shall remain vested in the state govt.

15.2 A Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) shall be signed between the selected agency and the respective Project Director, ATMA of the concerned district as per the proforma decided by the Department of Agriculture & Cane Development, Jharkhand to provide Soil Testing Facilities for an initial period of 5 years, which may be extended in case of satisfactory performance.

15.3 It is expected that each of such Soil Testing Laboratory would start its operations within 9 months of such date of MOA, failing which penalty as specified in para 6 shall be imposed.

15.4 Each such Soil Testing Laboratory (STL) is expected to provide test reports of soil samples at an average rate of 1000 samples per month. Test reports and sample analysis will be technically evaluated for accuracy and precision *by BAU/ Department*.

15.5 The ownership of the equipments installed by the agency for Soil Testing purposes shall remain vested with the agency but such

equipments, once installed, shall not be removed without the prior and due authorization for the same by the Department of Agriculture & Cane Development, Government of Jharkhand.

15.6 The rate of testing of soil samples may be amended by the Department of Agriculture & Cane Development, Jharkhand from time to time as per the requirement.

15.7 The Department of Agriculture & Cane Development, Jharkhand shall extend all possible assistance to the selected agency for each district in getting soil samples collected.

However remuneration, if any, shall be payable by the agency to the soil sample collecting personnel's.

15.8 The selected agency shall undertake vide publicity to create awareness for testing of soil samples among the farmers. The Department of Agriculture & Cane Development, Jharkhand would extend all possible assistance to the agency in this regard by adopting various print/audio/video mediums.

15.9 The safety and security of the soil testing laboratory and its equipment shall be the responsibility of the agency. No claim for damages, if any, would be admissible against the Department of Agriculture & Cane Development, Jharkhand in this regard

15.10 Separate expression should be submitted for each district, which should be marked upon the envelop in bold letters " **Expression for setting up of soil testing laboratory in(name) district of Jharkhand** ".

16. The EOI, which is not submitted in prescribed Performa shall be rejected.

Any additional particulars can be furnished in the accompanied letter of statement.

17. The EOI who do not contain full details regarding technical particulars, test certificates, delivery period etc will not be considered.

18. The undersigned reserves the rights to reject whole or part of any or all of the contenders without assigning any reason.

19. CANCELLATION OF ORDER

The authority issuing the order reserves the right to cancel whole or part of the supply orders of those companies/organizations who will be found defaulter for delayed installation & commissioning of the job or the supply of non standard quality of materials.
