Sub: Addition of more districts of Jharkhand under National Food Security Mission-Rice- regarding.

Ref: Decision taken in the meeting held on 29.6.2009 in Ranchi under the Chairmanship of Cabinet Secretary, Govt. of India & Our letter no. 5238, dated 06.08.2009

With regards to the subject mentioned above, it is submitted that rice, a major rain dependent food crop in Jharkhand occupying an area of 16 lakh, is grown in different topo-sequence viz. upland, midland & low land. Tribal population of the State is largely dependent on paddy crop. However its productivity is low (1.8 t/ha) against national average (2.1 t/ha). Several constraints such as delayed seeding in upland as well as delayed transplanting in mid/low land owing to delay in south-west monsoon coupled with moisture stress during growing period, low seed replacement, low fertilizer consumption, lack of weeds diseases and pests management are responsible for low rice production and productivity in the region.

National Food Security Mission to enhance the production and productivity of rice in Jharkhand is running only in five districts, namely Gumla, Hazaribagh, Ranchi, Simdega and West Singhbhum. However, there is a need to expand the coverage of this programme.

There is scope of increasing production of Rice through area expansion and productivity enhancement in a sustainable manner in Dumka, East Singhbhum, Saraikela, Giridih, Dhanbad, Jamtara, Deoghar and Godda districts.

The area, production and Productivity in these districts have been depicted in Table 1.
